Phase I: Design Native Hawaiian Research Agenda (FY17-18, **FY 18-19**)

Objective: Design Native Hawaiian Research Agenda

Launch project to collectively identify purposes for, beneficiaries of, funders, stakeholders, collaborative work to be tracked, completed and disseminated for the benefit of families and communities, toward abundant communities.

Deliverables/Milestones: Research Agenda

Phase II: Connect, Coordinate, Study, Monitor, Juxtapose and Report (**FY 18-19, FY 19-20**)

Objective: Connect, Coordinate, Study, Monitor, Juxtapose and Report

Deliverables/Milestones: Track and/or conduct Native Hawaiian Education Research, juxtapose and report on the insights with health, housing, and other related Native Hawaiian data.

Phase III: Next Steps (FY 19-20, FY 20-21)

Objective: Determine Next Steps Based on Phase II Work

Deliverables/Milestones: Based on research information, insights and outcomes of Phase II, determine appropriate systemic next steps.

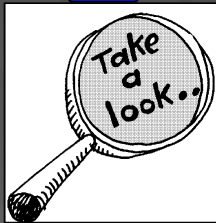
Systemic Road Map

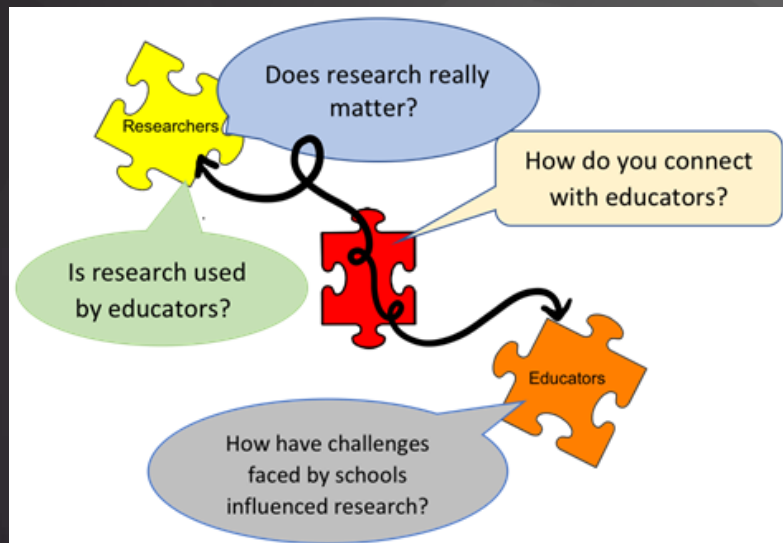
