- Medicaid and Nutrition programs accounted for nearly 64% of the Hawai'i's allocation.

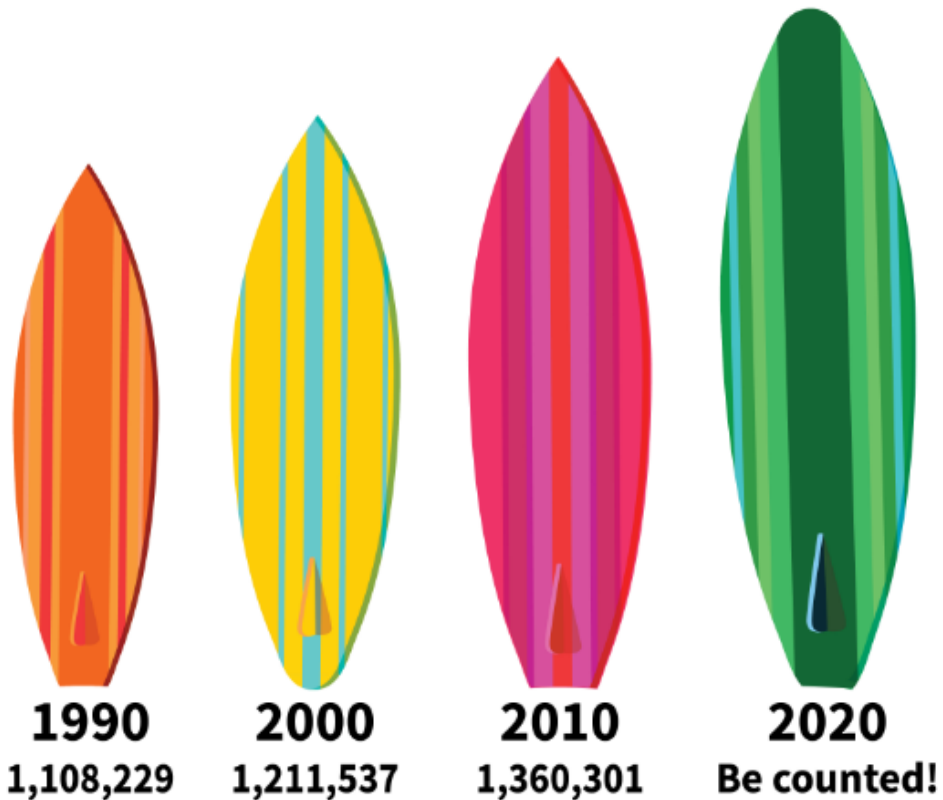

- Per U. S. Census Bureau studies, Hawai'i population was undercounted by 2.16% in 2000 and 0.44% in 2010. However, the undercounted rate is believed to be much larger.
- For each percent of undercount, the state will lose \$37million/year for 10 years.

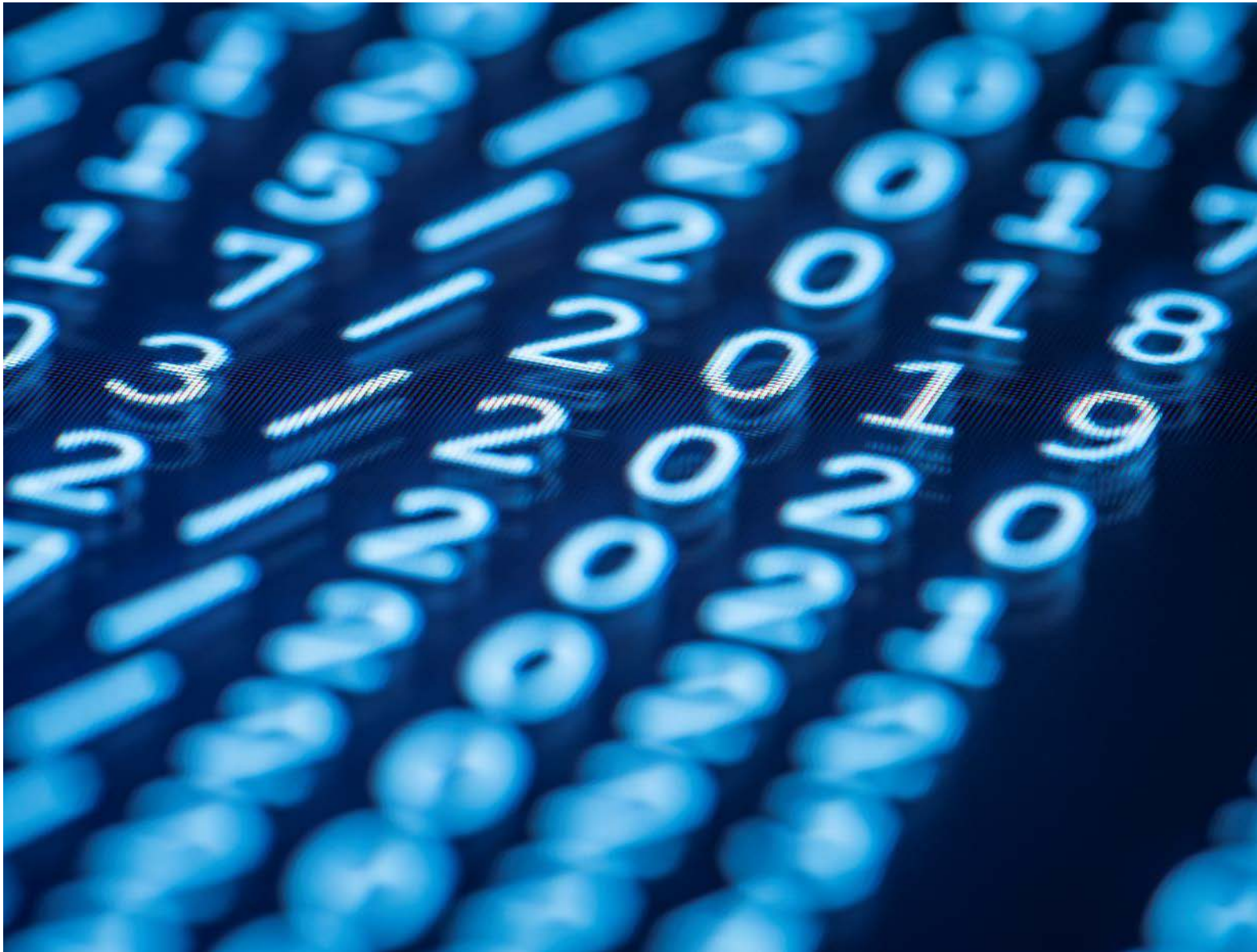
